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### **Terms of use Mountaincart**

#### Terms of use for the mountaincarts -Supplement for taking a child on an adult's lap

#### These instructions apply in addition to the general terms of use for the mountaincarts -If a child is taken along on the lap of an adult supervisor, the following must also be observed in particular:

- These instructions apply in addition to the general terms of use for the mountaincarts If a child is taken along on the lap of an adult supervisor, the following must also be observed in particular: The adult places their feet on the two footrests of the handlebars during the entire descent and their hands are always on the handlebar grips or on the brake handles so that they are ready to brake at all times and the handlebars are held firmly in their hands.
- > The child sits on the adult's lap; the child's legs must go over the adult's thighs to the right and left, the child's feet must not touch the ground.
- It must be ensured that the child holds on to the handlebars with both hands at all times. The adult supervisor must assess and confirm whether the child has the maturity to do so during the entire descent.
- If the child is unable to hold on to the handlebars at all times, the descent must be ended immediately. It must also be ensured that a sufficiently large mountaincart is used (size L or XL) and that the adult has sufficient visibility of the descent route at all times.
- A particularly cautious riding style and a correspondingly adapted, moderate speed is also required!
