



Safety Instruction Mountaincart

How to break	Attention oncoming traffic	Keep right & ride one behind the other	Terms of use/ Age restriction
Left brake Left rear wheel Right brake Right rear wheel Brake evenly with both brakes at the same time.	Due to hikers, bikers and cars, therefore drive with "half visibility"! In general, the speed must be regulated so that the cart can be brought to a standstill at any time with half visibility.	Do not drive side by side. The slower driver has priority! Always drive on the right side of the road and do not cut the road bends!	Adults and young people aged 16 and over may use the cart unaccompanied by an adult. Children aged 10 and over 140 cm tall may ride alone when accompanied by an adult. Children under the age of 10 and children under 140 cm tall may only use a cart together with a parent or guardian (father/mother). The duty of care is the responsibility of the legal guardian (see also special transportation guidelines for use by 2 people).

Terms of use Mountaincart

Terms of use for the mountaincars - Supplement for taking a child on an adult's lap

These instructions apply in addition to the general terms of use for the mountaincars -

If a child is taken along on the lap of an adult supervisor, the following must also be observed in particular:

- ▶ These instructions apply in addition to the general terms of use for the mountaincars - If a child is taken along on the lap of an adult supervisor, the following must also be observed in particular: The adult places their feet on the two footrests of the handlebars during the entire descent and their hands are always on the handlebar grips or on the brake handles so that they are ready to brake at all times and the handlebars are held firmly in their hands.
- ▶ The child sits on the adult's lap; the child's legs must go over the adult's thighs to the right and left, the child's feet must not touch the ground.
- ▶ It must be ensured that the child holds on to the handlebars with both hands at all times. The adult supervisor must assess and confirm whether the child has the maturity to do so during the entire descent.
- ▶ If the child is unable to hold on to the handlebars at all times, the descent must be ended immediately.
It must also be ensured that a sufficiently large mountaincart is used (size L or XL) and that the adult has sufficient visibility of the descent route at all times.
- ▶ A particularly cautious riding style and a correspondingly adapted, moderate speed is also required!


